- Helmet: EN 966 (air sports), EN1077 (winter sports) 8/15
- Live tracking system as specified by the organizer
- Backup device that records the movements in "IGC format" and saves them.
- Charged phone that works on the Swiss cell phone network. The athlete is responsible for ensuring a sufficient power supply for the entire duration of the competition.
